- All BRMC Med-Camp students will be housed at a hotel in close proximity to the hospital with BRMC Security at all times.
  - Group transportation will be provided for the students.
  - Chaperones and security will also be provided by BRMC AT ALL TIMES.
  - As we are a Baptist hospital, it will be directed toward Christian principles.
  - We are a live hospital, some activities may need to be restructured around the Medical Staff, should situations dictate.
  - Learn from medical professionals in a world-class hospital.
  - Students are met at the airport and personally escorted.
  - Parents will know the names of the BRMC counselors and involved staff, with contact numbers.
  - Students will have access to their email, cells, etc. as permissible, for communication with parents.
  - Activities for students will be planned in the evenings, including movie night, a visit to Cumberland Falls, team activities, and fellowship.
  - Small intimate groups will be escorted into the training areas, with an instructor and/or counselor, as applicable.
  - Hospital Floor time to include, as available, - Medical-Surgical, Women's Health, Laboratory, Pharmacy, Respiratory, Physical Rehabilitation, Medical Records, Outpatient Clinics, CCU, Non-Invasive Care, Radiology, Outpatient Diagnostic Center, Infusion Clinic, ER, Surgery, Cath Lab and Ambulatory
  - Course curriculum to include lectures: Medical Ethics, Infection Control, Professionalism, etc.
  - Skills Lab: Blood Pressures, Temperature, Blood Sugar, Cholesterol, Audio, Eyes
  - Shadow participating Physicians' office
- 1<sup>st</sup> year Med-Camp cost: \$1125 includes meals, activities, lodging, CPR certification, First Aid certification and hands on training**
- Incentive of \$125 with early registration by May 1, 2010***
- \*\* One set of scrubs and a stethoscope will be given to each student upon completion**
- \*\* The \$125 incentive will be used for books (each student that attends a higher educational institution upon graduation will receive \$125 donation from BRMC to be used toward books)**
